

Butterfly Chair Series Design: Niels Gammelgaard, 2013

In 2010 a competition was arranged for a new chair for the Queen and her guests. The existing chair is a plain, gold-lacquered Polish chair, so the evaluation was that based on our proud traditions here in Denmark with regards to the design and production of furniture we should be able to create a successor ourselves.

Niels Gammelgaard approached Magnus Olesen, presenting the Butterfly chair, that had a very distinctive design. The seat and back of the chair were symmetric like the wings of a butterfly, and at the same time the back was transparent, so the beautiful dresses would be visible through the back. However, the chair did not win, so further developments were made and at Snedkernes Efterårsudstilling in 2012 a new version was presented, and finally, in 2013, the whole Butterfly range was launched.

The Butterfly chair series still has its characteristic butterfly look, but now it consists of a complete series with a number of different bases either in wood or steel.




